#### **Financials**

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Basics Financial summary provided by Carol.	Financial Highlights:  *Our actual <b>Net Cash position is \$83,798</b> (including ~\$42,000 in the rebuilding fund).  This is \$36,168 below the beginning of the fiscal year.	
	*We have \$8700 in pending expenses: \$6,000 canoe, \$1,900 for launch repairs and \$1,800 for outstanding expenses. *On a seasonally adjusted basis, <b>Net Income is \$98,000</b> , and ~\$2,000 ahead of budget. This excludes \$15,000 for a spring/summer fundraiser.	*Of the ~\$6600 >90 days AR, we will make a determination this month about uncollectable fees, and determine recourse for each individual.
	*Total Expenses are \$130,125, ~\$3,000 over budget: Capital expenses for new equipment purchases are \$2225 over budget, plus approximately \$10,000 in additional expenses are pending: -\$6,000 for paddlers' canoe (does not include skirt or transport) -\$2,500 for covers for new boats -\$1,000 for new rack purchased -\$500 slings	*Mike Martinez has an outstanding receivable of \$2700 (\$300*9 months) for storage fees  *We will work with individuals, program leads and coaches to identify individuals who are past due and using the facilities.
	Equipment maintenance expenses are \$3337 over budget, with an additional \$1,900 for launch repairs pending. We under-budgeted for maintenance as we greatly expanded the fleet of boats, use more fuel, and appropriately focused on preventative maintenance for launches and equipment.  *On a seasonally adjusted basis (for membership cyclicality) through May 10, 2010, Net Income (loss) is \$(32,000) or \$871 under budget.	*We continue to maintain the policy that individuals >30 days past due on accounts (without other financial arrangements) cannot use BIAC facilities, equipment or participate in races.

	Administrative, utilities and taxes are below budget.	
	Accounts Receivable:  *We have reduced our total outstanding accounts receivables to \$16,122, a reduction of \$11,320 from \$27,442 in April.

Initial items which should be addressed:</li> <li>1) Membership management – billing, payments, reporting, etc.</li> <li>2) Membership communication – Ability to reach past/present members</li> <li>3) Application support, and ease of use for a user and admin</li> <li>A follow up meeting will be scheduled to finalize the requirements document.</li> </ul>
