## Financials

Basics	Financial summary provided by Carol. Financial Highlights: *Our actual Net Cash position is \$77,941 (including the rebuilding fund). This is \$42,024 below the beginning of the fiscal year. *We have \$7664 in pending expenses: \$7500 in rent due to Redwood City (3 months)+ miscellaneous expenses. * Net Income is \$103,000 on a seasonally adjusted basis,, and ~\$27,000 below our seasonally adjusted budget.	<b>Capital Expenses:</b> *We budgeted \$87,500 for total capital expenses in FY2010. To date we have spent \$66,500, and we have approximately \$5,000 in committed capital expenses outstanding. This leaves approximately \$16,000 in unexpended capital for FY2010. Since we did not have a spring fundraiser (targeted to raise \$15k), we should freeze all additional capital expenses. This impacts the rowing programs as the paddling program has expended
	*Total Expenses are \$141,029, \$14,721 below budget. However, we owe \$7500 in rent and have pending capital expenditures of approximately \$5k for slings, shell rack, and boat covers pending. Equipment maintenance expenses are \$3k over budget. Administrative, utilities and taxes are considerably below budget. *Through June 15, 2010, Net Income (loss) is \$(38,038), a \$12,100 negative variance.	its full capital budget. Accounts Receivable: *We continued to reduce our total outstanding accounts receivables to a \$12,842, down \$3,280 vs. May. [Officially we have \$17,242 outstanding; however, I received notice that \$4400 is in process from Serra High School ].
