* Financials

- Review financials of the last month Current financials are good. Current balance = \$106,926 Only \$1827 of Fall Regatta income is currently on deposit. Slow month US Rowing insurance (\$2879) for 2007 has been paid. Signatures at Citibank have been completed by new \$ officers (DK, MhG, Pma)
- Approve budget for upcoming months
 Need to send \$2,800 to NorCal for fall ergs purchases (Mh) to have 5 new ergs.
 Need to get to 12 ergs (min, 16 max). Buy two more thru MikeS now also (+\$1600).
 Ask each junior program (NorCal, Serra) to own five ergs (BIAC=6). Total of 16. Pma
 MikeM to make 9 vinyl BIAC labels for our ergs (7 Model Ds, 2 Model Cs w/o monitor)
- Fundraising plans Holiday Auction Dinner effort kicked off: Date = Jan 20. New Fundraising web site area available for Members Only. Pma to get it public. Could create a Fall Regatta album to sell photos online Visa, MC, PP (MM, Pma)

- Marina management
 - Electrical work has started! (Dec 18). (MM).

Keypad boat house entry lock being revised (MM) initial=00000, later combo=**02913** Proposal to put a light on the north side of the boathouse to deter bums (MM). Rebuilt carburetor is ready for BIAC launch #2 (MM this weekend?).

Proposal for "Members Only" sign at BIAC. (MM).

Contract for a fence at the rear of the boathouse with gate. MM has \$850 est. (=Go!) Mike Still to *still* fix pontoon on houseboat.

Jan 20 work party scheduled (remove old sheds at entrance and fix container roof).

Legal document for tenant agreements is still in draft circulation. (DA)

North end walkway needs improvement (CDBA share?).

Container storage roofs are leaking – need to clear the roofs & fix. (MM)

Proposal to replace ramp landing floats. Need to design & cost estimate (DJ & MM).

Need to make a list of tasks for January 20 work party (who runs this?).

Dan is now handling purchase of two stern loader 4+ from Santa Clara. What's our DMV registration status on the launches? (MM ->Claire). Proposal (still) to buy 2 used Aeros (\$2750 ea) from OWRC and sell 2 old ones. (DA). Cox box czar (still) needed to maintain current batch (of 4) and buy a new one (spare).
